Conservancies should strictly adhere to MET Standard Operating Procedures:

- Holding of AGMs
- Conducting elections
- Managing as per GMUP
- Producing annual financial statements

50% of all conservancy income should be invested into socio-economic development projects to benefit the community.

Wildlife crime is theft from the community. Report suspicious activity to game guards who will forward the information to the relevant authorities.

HWC can be reduced by residents who take the right precautions, including protection of gardens and crop fields, predator-proof kraals and guard dogs.
